Hadi, Bonjour and Hello,

Thanks to everyone who attended our Talk About Learning Time yesterday. We are so proud of our kids and their families and love when we get to talk about your kids and their progress with you.

Tomorrow is our first celebration of our new (and so far very successful) Primary Numeracy Skills Intervention process. For the last 5 weeks our grades 1 to 3 students have been working on the skills of patterns in numeracy. Students worked in skill specific intervention groups for 3 week and then joined back in their homeroom class to use their new skills. On October 23rd students will celebrate their learning by cycling around learning stations in each classroom to put their knowledge and ability in patterns to use. Our next unit will be Number Sense.

This Friday is the provincial Pro-d Day. There will be no school for students.

October 31st is our Dress-Up Day. Please check out the info in this newsletter about our dress-up day "rules" – no masks, no "weapons" and no blow-up costumes and about our intermediate dance sponsored by our One McLeod Council. Each grade 4 to 6 student who is attending the dance needs to bring \$3.00 please.

November 13th is the day for retakes, class pictures and our panorama picture. Students who were absent the first picture day will get their individual picture taken this day. If you need a retake (pictures should be coming home soon), please have students bring the first package with them and report to the library for retake time.

Remember that our Core Competency focus this year is "**COMMUNICATE TO CONNECT.**" We are continuing to learn and practice the skills for active listening and why it is so important.

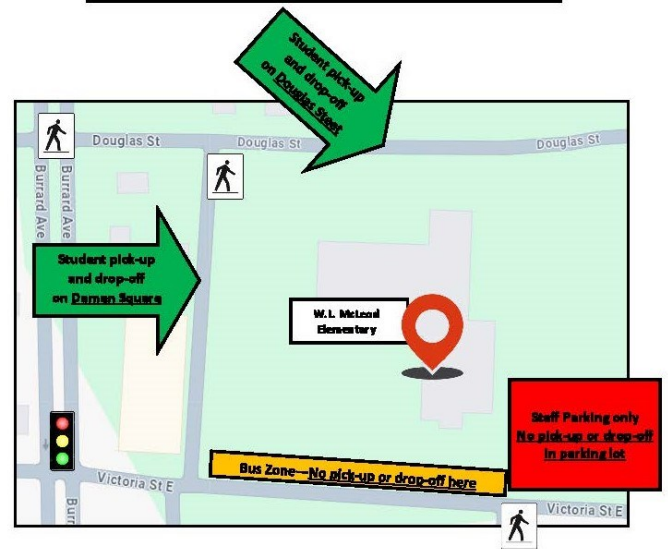

Student Pick-up & Drop-off at W.L. McLeod Elementary


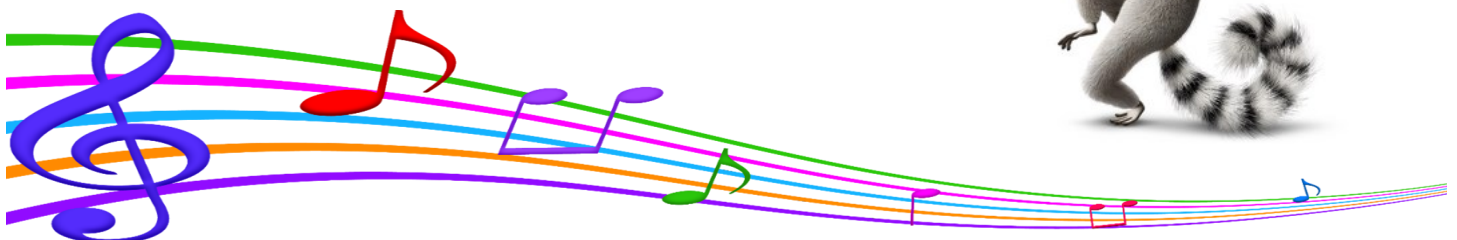
