Our Term One report cards will be coming home on Thursday, November 24th. I wanted to give you a heads up that things will look a bit different – again. In our work to communicate better we have adjusted a few things. Our reading level graphic has been expanded and, moving forward, we hope to track reading growth for our students carrying on each year, like a baby's height and weight chart. We're excited about this move to expand this project we began last year. Also, we are getting a head start on the new BC Reporting Order that will begin in September 2023. The BC system does not support some of the exciting stuff we did last year (new rubric words, an easy indication of support for learners in need, etc.). We hope that September 2023 will bring an updated BC-wide format that honours the communication we value so much at McLeod.

This Friday is our grade 6 volleyball play day and grade 4/5 handball play day. We hope our teams have piles of fun and play hard. Because of this day we will move our Team Jersey Day to Thursday, November 24th.
