We hope that September 2023 will bring an updated BC-wide format that honours the communication we value so much at McLeod.

This Friday is our grade 6 volleyball play day and grade 4/5 handball play day. We hope our teams have piles of fun and play hard. Because of this day we will move our Team Jersey Day to Thursday, November 24th.
