W.L. McLeod Strong Start

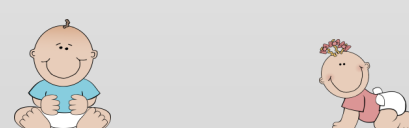
A free program here at our school for children ages 0-5, with their caregivers. Snack is provided.
