- **a.** Fundraiser Updates:

- b. Christmas Concert Students had PJ day on the Thursday before break. They got to watch the Christmas concert in their classes on this day as well as receive their gingerbread men from the PAC. # d. Farm to School:

- Walk in Cooler Looking into large cooler, it would need to be inside or covered (Michelle will find out more about this and look into pre built sheds or a c-can).
- ii. Grant Government grant should reopen soon, we'll apply when available. Michelle will call to check if the gaming grant can go towards the cooler.
- iii. Kitchen Update Michelle is going to look into the cost and nutrition of the food we are serving.
