


McLeod 2023 Christmas Concert


We are so happy to be bring our annual Christmas Concert back to our stage this year. We will be performing in the afternoon Tuesday, December 19 and Wednesday, December 20.

- \* 604.2 Student Photograph/Video/Audio and Media Consent
- \* 604.4 District Technology and Network Access
