Friday is team Jersey Day. We'd love to see any jersey – hockey, soccer, favorite pro team and more.

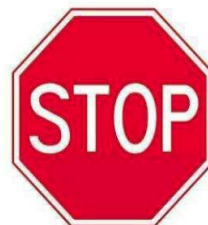
