Despite a temporary hold while we await further information from the Province regarding recently legislated cell phone restriction requirements, the School District 91 Policy Committee continues to accept public feedback regarding *Policy 604.1 – Digital Technology, Consent and Privacy*.

If adopted, this new Policy 604.1 will replace the following existing policies:

- \* 502.6 Use of Cell Phones and Digital Devices
- \* 604.1 Digital Technology
- \* 604.2 Student Photograph/Video/Audio and Media Consent
- \* 604.4 District Technology and Network Access
