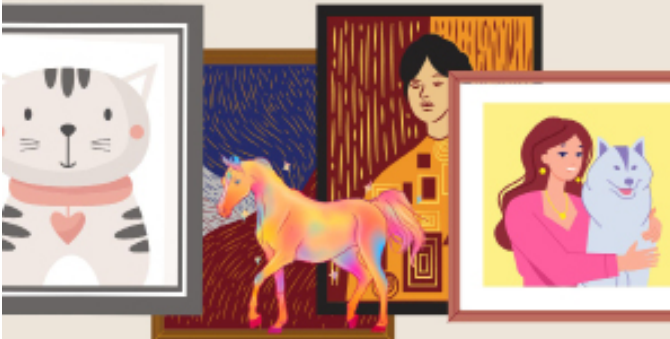

A FREE COMMUNITY BHANGRA SESSION HOSTED BY THE GOOD NEIGHBOURS COMMITTEE WITH **GURDEEP PANDHER**

2PM ON SATURDAY, JUNE 1, 2024
AT FERLAND PARK IN VANDERHOOF, BC
(CORNER OF CHURCH AVE & VICTORIA ST)

Gurdeep Pandher is a Yukon-based Bhangra artist and educator. He lives in a small cabin without running water in the wilderness, creating performance pieces that bring together people from all backgrounds while promoting inclusivity. He is best known for bringing joy, hope and positivity during the pandemic through his online dance classes, videos and uplifting messages... often dancing on frozen lakes and rivers in temperatures as cold as -45°C!

Bhangra is a traditional folk dance of Punjab. Gurdeep's Bhangra dance sessions are based on body and mind movement. They are a joyful way to introduce physical exercise and a nourishing route to a wholesome mental well-being wonderland.

This event has been made possible by a group of dedicated volunteers with funding from the Government of Canada, Government of British Columbia, and the District of Vanderhoof.
