7. OLD Business:

- **a.** Fundraiser Updates:
 - Purdy's Orders were due back in today. We did amazing on this fundraiser. Over \$3,000 in total sales, leaving us with over \$700 in profit.
- **b.** Teacher Funds Dannilee made all the cards. Mandi and Amber went to the bank to get the money and stuffed them and dispersed them.
- **c.** Computer Lab Keep on the agenda for the future meetings. Nothing new to add at this time.
- d. Walk in Cooler/Outdoor Refrigeration We have put in our application for the project. The actual project total including labour will be approximately \$76,000. The actual cost for materials will be approximately \$56,000 (which is what the application is requesting). We are not sure when we should hear back on this.
- **e.** Carnaval Carnaval activities went really well. The kids loved the taffy. It turned out so sticky though! School wide bingo went great. Students loved it.
- **f.** Pink Shirt Day Videoing went well for Libby. Lots of positive feedback on it from the community.

8. NEW Business:

- **a.** Plants Fundraiser Anna was absent so couldn't discuss. We will discuss at the next meeting.
- b. Indoor Garden We applied for the grant for this and received it. The grant covers \$995. Michelle will purchase the unit. The Farm to School account will cover any tax and shipping. Mandi has contacted Ace to see if we can get donations for things like seeds/soil. This unit will be great for plants like lettuces and herbs. Would be good to speak to teachers to see if any of them would like some things planted in their windows.
- **c.** 2022 Pink Shirt Day It would be lovely to do a buddy project next year with the students where they pair up and decorate their own pink shirts. PAC would supply the pink shirts and the items to decorate them with.
- **d.** Number Sense Math has been an ongoing struggle in the entire province. We are planning to put together a "number sense committee", this committee would contain K-6 students and focus on finding ways to help put the focus on playing with numbers and learning more number sense in K-3 grades. Plan to

meet with the committee soon.

- e. Report Card Idea Libby presented a "new" report card prospect that would ideally begin next September if it was to go through. This report card would have a section showing a better idea of what grade level students are reading at, and what the reading goal for them would be for that year. Libby will include the report card in the newsletter to get parent's opinions.
- f. Janet Mort Literacy Candace brought it to our attention that Janet Mort has written a new book. Janet Mort previously wrote the book about the Blitz program. The district is working with DPAC to create a series of videos to show the kids. We don't have too much information about the project yet. Bring this item to old business for the next meeting.
