



Despite a temporary hold while we await further information from the Province regarding recently legislated cell phone restriction requirements, the School District 91 Policy Committee continues to accept public feedback regarding Policy 604.1 — Digital Technology, Consent and Privacy.

If adopted, this new Policy 604.1 will replace the following existing policies:

- * 502.6 Use of Cell Phones and Digital Devices
- * 604.1 Digital Technology
- * 604.2 Student Photograph/Video/Audio and Media Consent
- * 604.4 District Technology and Network Access
