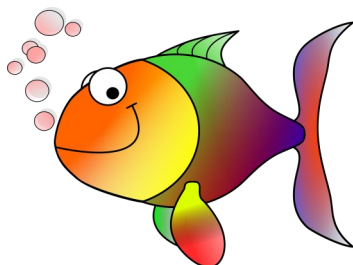

This is a way for us to check in on student progress in mathematics. It is especially important this year as we have tried to make a significant shift in practice to focus on helping our students to love and trust numbers. Our intermediate students have completed the RAD reading assessment and teachers will continue to work with primary and intermediate students to ensure we know all we can about reading progress. Please remember, as we work to identify reading abilities in students, reading is much more than just decoding (reading the words). Understanding the text (comprehension) is a significant and vital part of reading ability.

If you know any families who have children who will be registering for Kindergarten for September 2022 please encourage them to come into the school to do so as soon as possible. This really helps us with our planning. We also want to make sure any future McLeod families are invited to our Welcome to Kindergarten BBQ on June 7th. 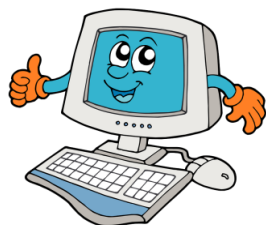
