#### 8. NEW Business:

- a. Vision Zero Road Safety Grant Program Deadline is January 14th. Is this something we would be interested in applying for. Discussed and nothing seems necessary at the moment. So we will pass on this.
- b. Pink Shirt Day Discussed that we should do something cool this year like having the kids designing their own shirts. We would have to order the shirts to get here on time. Libby will check with teachers to figure out sizes. We should also do it for our staff as well. Veronica and Dannilee will do some research on wholesalers to find us a good price on shirts and fabric paint (or other options).
- c. Farm to School We did not get our infrastructure grant for the cold room. There is a farm to school cafeteria grant for \$10,000 that only goes to 30 students across Canada. Michelle was discussing with Darren Carpenter that maybe this could be a great Vanderhoof school project that all schools can have access to. Darren thinks that even without the grant money, we may be able to pull it off. She will keep in contact with him.
