

Any class with 50 or more items will receive cookies.

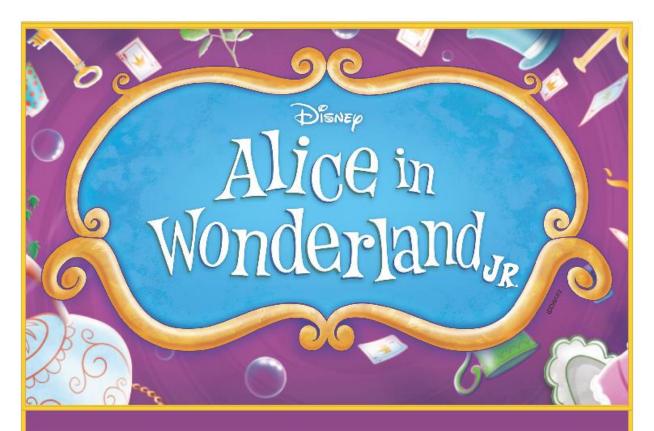
Any class with over <u>200</u> items will receive a pancake breakfast.
