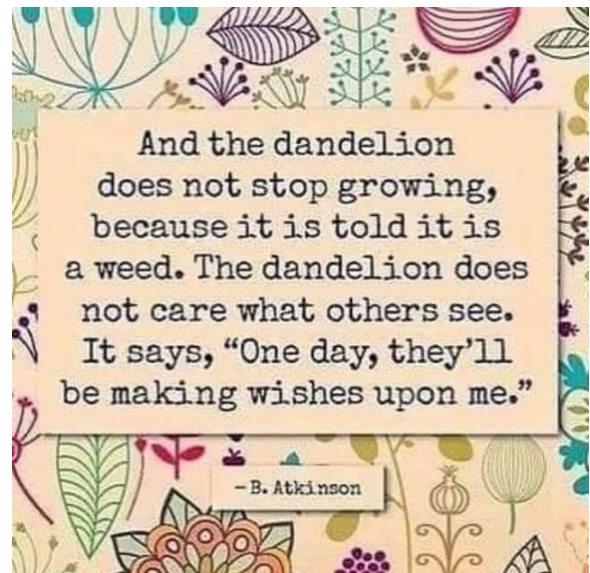

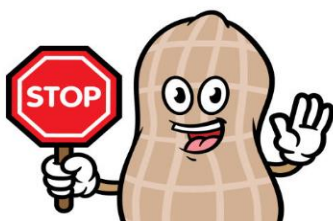

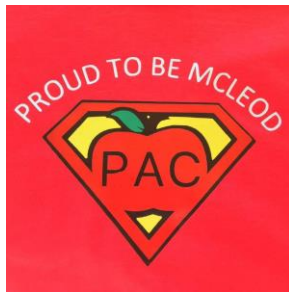
CONTACTING ME

Any class with 50 or more items will receive cookies.

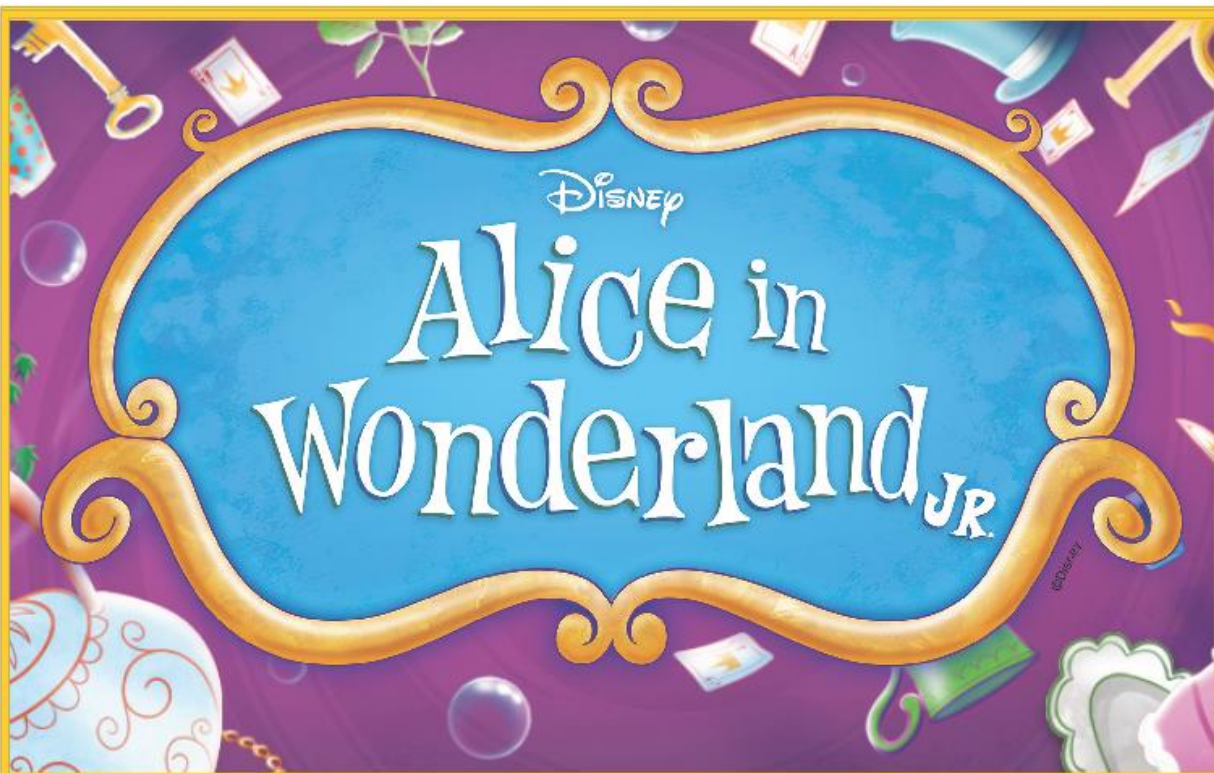
Any class with over **200** items will receive a pancake breakfast.

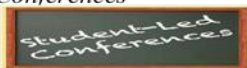
