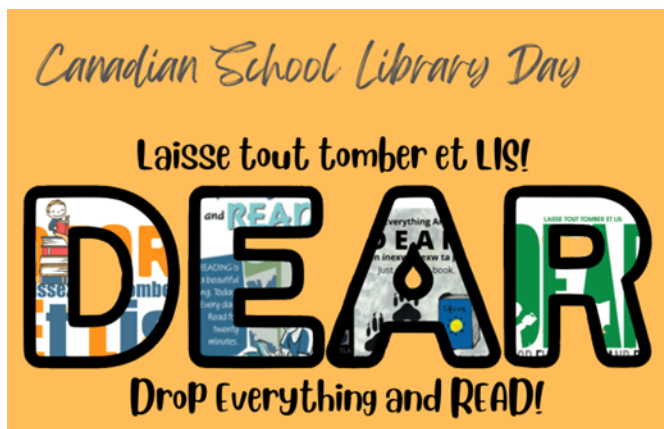
STUDENT AFFORDABILITY FUND 2022-2023

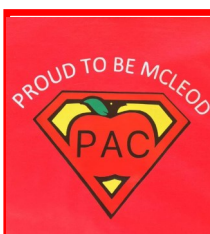
